Each year CADS recognizes those members and volunteers who have contributed in many and varied ways in the promotion and development of Adaptive Snowsports in Canada.

Nominations accepted for:

- Administrator of the Year: This award is given to the person who has demonstrated outstanding administrative qualities and actions for their division/club. (Being sure deadlines are met, immediate action when necessary, running a smooth division or club.)
- Volunteer of the Year: This person has given a great deal of themselves to the program/division/or club during the season.
- Adaptive skier or snowboarder of the Year: A member who has improved their skiing/boarding skills during the season.
- Instructor of the Year: This award is given to the instructor that has given a great deal of himself/herself in their program.
- Coach of the year: For outstanding athlete development
- Ski Area of the year: For outstanding contribution to adaptive Snowsports
- Division Sponsor of the year: For outstanding contribution to a CADS division
- President's Award: The President gives this award to a CADS member for service to CADS.
- Karl Hilzinger Award: This award is given to the person who has given exceptional service to CADS and to their division/program/club for a number of years.
- Bob Gilmour Inspirational Leader Award: This is an award *In memory of Bob Gilmour* who dedicated his life to enriching other people's lives, especially through skiing for people with disabilities. This award is presented to an individual who demonstrates inspirational commitment and dedication
